## **KS3 Home Learning ART**

## **Tonal Drawing (All years)**

You will need a pencil, pencil sharpener, paper, and an eraser.

Find a quiet place to work. (100 min)

Select a glass to draw and place it in front of you.

Observed the glass, look at the reflections, tones and shadows.

Sketch the outline of the glass carefully.

Use very little pressure so the pencil is barely touching the paper.

Keep checking the proportions.


Add lines to show the reflections.

(Ask someone to look and see if you can improve the outline, sometimes another pair of eyes can be useful)

When the shape looks correct begin to build the tones.

Look closely at the tonal values (that's the different shades).

Allow the white paper to be the lightest tone.

If you are absent for more that one art lesson, repeat the process using another shiny object Eg Apple, Vase, Cutlery etc
