We are concerned to note that "chosen\_forename" is attendance since the beginning of the academic year is "percentage\_attendance".

The government has identified 93% or above as being the acceptable level of attendance for pupils to achieve their full potential at school. However, as a proactive, supportive school our own target is 95% and we would ask all parents and pupils to work with us to reach this. As you can see from the enclosed Registration Certificate, your child's attendance falls below this percentage.

How does your child compare?

Attendance during one school year	Equals this number of days absent	Which is approximately this many weeks absent	Which means this number of lessons missed
95%	9 days	2 weeks	50 lessons
90%	19 days	4 weeks	100 lessons
85%	29 days	6 weeks	150 lessons

We are aware that absences are generally explained but due to the change in the government's Persistent Absence criteria, we are obliged to advise you that this level of attendance needs to be raised with you.

«chosen\_forename»'s tutor has recently discussed attendance with «him\_her» to address any possible barriers to «his\_her» attendance and to offer support and we do hope that with your help we can look forward to an improvement in this attendance figure in the future.
