GUIDANCE TO THE USE OF CONSEQUENCES

Due to the wide range of incidents that are possible in a School environment, it is neither practical nor realistic to try and list all possible infringements and their resulting consequences. The table below serves only to provide guidance when making decisions with regard to sanctions.

We always strive for a consistent approach, but individual circumstances will be taken into consideration when reaching decisions.

Ultimately, it is the drive for a successful outcome that helps to shape decisions.
