

- In Citizenship time you will be developing your CV, letters of application.

 - Employer Address
 - Company Name
 - Contact, Email and phone number

Some Tips

- Start early! Some employers, only take on one student for one week for the year.
- If you have a great idea, tell your parent/carer first, you might be surprised who they know who could take you..!
- You want to make sure you apply to more than one business, it's good to have options and you don't want to put all your eggs in one basket.
- Mrs Leonard can provide you with a list of suggestions of companies to approach in your Work Experience Appointment, but you must do your own research too.
- Practice the email you will send to employers when you are requesting a placement. Don't rely on your own proofreading skills, get a fresh pair of eyes to check everything. Remember you never get a second chance to make a first impression!
- Follow up all applications with a phone call but don't pester them. This can be quite daunting so why not practice with your parent/carer first and rehearse what you're going to say?
- If you are asked to attend an interview, discuss with your tutor or Mrs Leonard and they can talk this through with you so that you are well be prepared.
- Make sure that you have the digital forms completed as promptly as you can.




